Time limits for speeches are as follows: * 4th Grade 1-3 Minutes * 5th Grade 3-5 Minutes * 6th-8th Grades 3-7 Minutes * 9th-12th Grade 5-7 Minutes. High school (9-12 grade) speakers must present a 4-H speech.

And they must be serving as local leaders in their club or county wide.
